STATEMENT OF FAITH

- 1. The Statement of Faith articulates both an evangelical and Pentecostal doctrinal position. The following is a summary of the Statement of Faith:
- 2. The Church believes that the Holy Bible consisting of sixty-six books including the Old and the New Testament, is the inspired Word of God, a revelation from God to Man, concerning the will of God in all things necessary to our faith, conduct and salvation, so that whatever is not contained therein is not to be enjoined as an article of faith.
- 3. It believes in one God, eternally existing in three persons (Trinity), namely the God the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost.
- 4. It believes that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary. It also believes in Christ's Death, burial, resurrection, and ascension.
- 5. It believes that man was created in the image and likeness of God, but fell by voluntary transgression and his only hope of redemption and salvation is in Jesus Christ; that all have sinned and come short of the glory of God, that repentance is commanded of God for all, and is necessary for forgiveness of sin; that salvation, new birth and justification are wrought by the grace of God, and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and the renewing work of the Holy Ghost.
- 6. It believes in the ordinance of believer's baptism by immersion, in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost, for all who repent and believe Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.
- 7. It believes that all believers are entitled to and earnestly seek the promise of the Father, the Baptism in the Holy Spirit according to the command of our Lord Jesus Christ; that the full consummation of the Baptism of the believers in the Holy Spirit is evidenced by the initial sign of speaking in tongues and subsequent manifestation of the Spiritual gifts and Fruit of the Holy Spirit.
- 8. It believes that the Lord's Supper, consisting of the elements of bread and the fruit of the wine, is a memorial of His sufferings and death
- 9. It believes that the deliverance from sickness is provided for all in Christ's atonement and is the privilege of all believers, and the anointing of the sick with oil for Divine healing and the laying on of hands.
- 10. It believes in the pre-millennial Second Coming of Christ
- 11. It believes in the promise of new heavens and a new earth wherein the righteous will dwell.
- 12. We believe in Jesus Great Commission and the Mission of the Church, in order to carry its mission, we need to proclaim the message of Jesus Christ, He is the one and only way to the Salvation. Apart from Him there is no other salvation

Available Programs

Know your options

Our distance programs are offered in two similar formats: Online and Hybrid

Online: Our online programs are fully available online, without any requirement to come to campus for any portion of the program. We will send notes and books to the following students. Students need to attend all sections of classes is Mandatory. Students must pay the fees before each semester examination start over without any fail.

Hybrid: Hybrid programs are mostly online, with the exception of two required, on-campus Intensive Weeks each year - one week in the fall and one week in the spring.

The choice is yours! For programs that are offered in both online and hybrid formats, you can decide each semester if you want to enroll as an online or hybrid student for that upcoming semester. Available Online and Hybrid Programs

BACHELOR OF THEOLOGY (B.Th)

- (a) The programme will consist of a total of 36 courses and thesis or two papers in lieu of thesis preferably in the area of professional involvement.
- (b) The following courses are recommended for study:
- 3 Years Six Semesters [Each Semester a student needs to meet the course requirements of 6 subjects, attending Classes, Presenting Papers, Reading Reports Term Exams and Final Exams]
- (c) A candidate who has passed the Plus Two who can join this program or if he has basic Christian ministerial experience more than 6 years and have well Biblical Knowledge in English language can also apply. He needs to take an Entrance Exam.

MASTER OF DIVINITY (M.Div.)

The *MASTER OF DIVINITY* is a three-years postgraduate-level degree programme which is designed to equip persons who has a passion to do much things for the kingdom of God, to provide the knowledge and skills necessary for meeting the needs of different forms of ministry and to develop academic proficiency for independent research. Specialization is available in **Old Testament, New Testament, Christian Theology, Christian Ministry (Pastoral Counselling) and Missions.**

The program will consist of a total of 30 courses and thesis or two papers in lieu of thesis preferably in the area of professional involvement. Only for **B.Th holders** the program will consist of a total of 20 Courses.

3 Years – Six Semesters [Each Semester a student needs to meet the course requirements of 5 subjects, attending Classes, Presenting Papers, Reading Reports Term Exams and Final Exams]

2 Years – Four Semesters [*Only for B.Th holders*] Each Semester a student needs to meet the course requirements of 5 subjects, attending Classes, Presenting Papers, Reading Reports Term Exams and Final Exams.

Candidates should hold a Degree relating theological or secular can apply for this course

Online. If you want or need to stay where you are while you pursue your seminary degree, JTCS offers the same courses in an online format that allows you to learn from your home or any remote location that has internet access. Online courses are ideal for students who:

- Can't uproot their lives and move to our JTCS campus.
- Are already working in a ministry setting and want to pursue a seminary degree while continuing in their current ministry role.
- Express themselves better through written words than through spoken words.

On-Site Hybrid. Hybrid courses combine the convenience of online education with the deeper relational connection of a classroom education. It's the best of both worlds! With hybrid courses, half of the course content is delivered online and the other half is delivered in one or two intensive onsite sessions—where you'll gather with the professor and other students enrolled in the course at our JTCS campus. Each onsite intensive session allows you to have face-to-face interactions with faculty and students. They generally convene from Thursday to Saturday. Hybrid courses are ideal for students who:

- Can't uproot their lives and move to JTCS, but desire to develop deeper, face-to-face relationships with faculty and other students.
- Want the convenience of an online education but also want to grow more holistically (spirit, mind, and body) with other adult students who are in a similar place of life.
